We want to love our community well and we take Romans 13:1-7 seriously. We are happy to quickly and creatively respond in ways that allow ministry to continue to thrive. This week President Trump asked that we not gather in groups of more than 10 people and we are being urged from all sources to remain at home as much as possible. In response to this, here are critical things we want you to know:

Worship Services:

Our online worship services are now extended through April 30. We will not gather on campus—so please join us from your living room each Sunday at 10:00 a.m. Our John series is on hold so we can focus on “Essentials.” This week’s message, “God is God... so I don’t have to be” will focus on what it means for my daily life that he is actually in control and has a plan. We will also spend time in worship through music and prayer. The service begins at 10:00 a.m. on our facebook page. You don’t need a facebook account to join us. Onsite Ministry/Church Office:

All on-campus gatherings are suspended. Offsite gatherings should observe all “social distancing” guidelines. This may mean meeting by telephone or online through tools such as “Zoom”. If this is new territory for you please contact us for assistance.

A team of special care shepherds has been assembled to keep us connected via phone and bring additional help to anyone who may need it.
