**We have a modified worship schedule these two weeks.** Here is what you need to know:

- **Palm Sunday, March 28**, we will have a **single outdoor service at 9:00 a.m. on the lawn**. This service will also be live streamed and posted to the Redemption Hill website as well as our Facebook and YouTube pages. We will NOT have an 11:00 a.m. indoor service.
- **Good Friday, April 2**, we will have **two services in the worship center at 4:30 and 7:00 p.m.** These services will also be live-streamed and posted to our website and media pages. Seating is limited so to serve the Redemption Hill family and be hospitable to guests **PLEASE RSVP** for the service you plan to attend. - **Easter Sunday, April 4**, we will have **two outdoor services at 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. on the lawn**. These services will also be live-streamed. We will NOT have an indoor service on Easter Sunday.
